



Photography and Video Policy

At Watsonian Football Club, we recognise that photography and video can be a sensitive area. However, we also understand the value these media offer — both in allowing parents to capture rugby’s “magic moments” and in providing valuable coaching feedback through video analysis.

With this in mind, photography and video recording are permitted at training sessions and matches — both at Myreside and at away venues — subject to the following guidelines:

- All young people must be appropriately dressed for the activity taking place.
- Photography and video recording should focus on the overall activity or group, rather than on any individual child.
- Anyone taking photographs or video must have a legitimate reason for doing so.
- Any concerns regarding inappropriate or intrusive photography or recording should be reported in confidence to the Club’s Child Protection Officer.

 - Maintenance and updating of the Club's player/parent/guardian database,
 - Administration purposes, including team selection and communication with players, parents, and guardians.
